In 1880 Rives was founded by Mr. Augusto Haupold. Initially the company focused on the manufacture and sale of wine and brandy. In 1965, Rives underwent a major reorganization where the grandson of the founder, Augusto Romero Haupold, introduced a full board structure and brought in directors who would help him achieve a new vision of a new dynamic Rives Pitman S.A.

New marketing, promotion and distribution techniques modeled on companies from Northern Europe and USA, which had pioneered successful strategies, were implemented.

From that point on, the company has had tremendous increase of efficiency and sales, while keeping true to the traditions of distilling a quality product that Rives has done throughout it's history of a one hundred and twenty years.

The rigorous high standard controls that Rives has maintained throughout the years allow the company to export their quality results to other global markets where people of the world can taste the delicious nature of a true Spanish made product.

Spanish Gin, internationally renowned, is distilled to the **London Dry Gin style**.

Gin Rives has been **produced in El Puerto De Santa Maria since 1880**, with extreme refinement and care, respecting the original recipe, which distinguishes its clean dry taste.

Eight different kinds of seeds and natural plants are used in the production, from many places of the world, all enhancing its own taste and aroma: Spanish Juniper, Moroccan Coriander, Belgian Angelica, Chinese Cassia, Italian Orris, Spanish Orange and Lemon and Chinese Liquorice.
